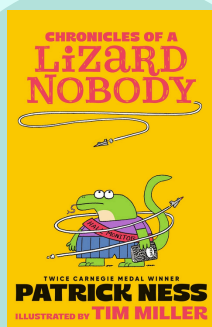

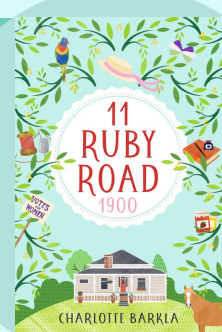


Small Acts by Kate Gordon and Kate Foster
